Sioux Falls Farm Show Set to Open for the 19th Year!

Sioux Falls, South Dakota – The Sioux Falls Farm Show is set for January 27, 28, & 29, with more than 350 exhibitors featuring over 1000 agricultural products and services. The annual three day event is expected to bring over 25,000 ag producers from South Dakota, Minnesota, Iowa, and Nebraska. The Sioux Falls Farm Show is part of Sioux Falls annual *Salute to Agriculture*. This event ties together the Sioux Falls Farm Show with the Sioux Empire Farm Show, the area's premier livestock event now in its 63rd year.

Exhibits at Two Great Locations

The Sioux Falls Farm Show features commercial agriculture exhibits at the Denny Sanford Premier Center (event center, convention center, & arena), and also the Expo building at the WH Lyon fairgrounds. Exhibits at both locations are open Jan 27, 28 & 29 (Wednesday through Friday). Exhibits open each day at 9am and free coffee and rolls are served from 8:30-10:00am in the Sioux Falls Arena. This year's show will host more than 380 exhibitors, compared to 350 exhibitors at last year's show. A key theme for this year's show is technologies that increase production and also reduce waste and lower expenses. Continued advancements in GPS, precision farming techniques, and UAV's, will be featured, as well as products and systems to manage and balance soil fertility.

Seminars, Health Screenings, and Opportunities to Win!
